Study Abroad Need – Based Scholarships

Policy 830 Date: January 10, 2010

The following outlines the policy and guidelines for providing need-based scholarships for Pamplin study abroad programs.

- Students will apply for need-based scholarships in the spring, for study abroad programs going the next academic year, the following fall semester, winter break, spring semester, and summer terms. The routine Pamplin application process will be used.
- Only Pamplin Business majors participating in Pamplin originated, faculty-lead study abroad programs are eligible.
- Awards of variable amounts of up to \$6,000 will be provided, as determined by the Pamplin Awards Committee at its April meeting, based on need, number of applicants, and the requirements of the donor fund agreements for students going in the following fall semester, winter break, spring semester, and summer terms.
- These need-based scholarships will be promoted each spring through both the routine channels of the Pamplin Undergraduate Office and through the International Programs Office.

Additionally, as the budget permits, the Dean, at his discretion, may allocate funds for scholarships for study abroad participants, regardless of need criteria.
